ADJUNCT PROFESSOR APPOINTMENTS

The Academic Senate passed the following resolution on April 20, 1978:

The position of adjunct professor is established to allow a department to receive the expertise of an individual recognized for noteworthy achievement. While the appointment may result in specific services rendered, the position should be seen as honorary and not as a substitute for visiting or part-time faculty appointments.

PROCEDURE: The department shall recommend a candidate to the Vice-President for Academic Affairs who shall make the appointment after consultation with the Committee on Leaves and Awards.
